

Boarding Specifications

Thank you for choosing Cobbs Ford Pet Health Center for your boarding needs. We understand how busy you are, and we hope these boarding regulations will help you be prepared for your pet's stay with us. If you want to speed up the check in process, bring in completed Boarding form. You can find our boarding form on this website in the form section. Indoor/Outdoor Runs:

- Minimum weight limit is 10 lbs
- For multiple pets in a run, the maximum combined weight limit is 120 lbs to help minimize territory issues and/or crowding issues.
- For multiple pets in a run, the weight has to be within 20 lbs of each other. This is to minimize any injury possibly caused by pets stepping on one another.
- If your pet is in heat, she will have to stay in a Suite or Condo to reassure no male dog can get to her. She will get her play time in the yard with the staff, but no other dogs.

Suites

- For multiple pets in a Suite, the maximum combined weight limit is 120 lbs to help minimize territory issues and/or crowding issues.
- For multiple pets in a Suite, the weight has to be within 20 lbs of each other. This is to minimize any injury possibly caused by pets stepping on one another.

Condos

- Maximum weight limit is 30 lbs. If your pet weighs more than 30 lbs it would not be able to move around comfortably.

Food

- We provide Science Diet Sensitive Stomach and Adult Small Bites dog food and Optimal Care cat food.
- If you bring your own food, it needs to be bagged in individual bags by the meal.
- We do not allow containers or big bags of food.
- We do not provide canned food; if your pet eats canned food, please provide it.
- We do not allow rawhides or any bone; but we do allow treats. (Pets can choke on bones of any kind)

Medicine

- If you bring medicine that is not prescribed by Cobbs Ford Pet Health Center, please leave detailed instructions on how to give it and all medications must be labeled. There is an extra charge per pet per night for our trained staff to administer medications.

Items

- We allow 1 toy per pet.
- We provide bedding and food/water bowls.
- We do not accept beds or food/ water bowls. They can get lost or broken.
- We do not keep leashes, collars, or harnesses. They can get chewed up, lost, or caught in the chain link. We provide paper collars while they stay with us.

Baths

- We provide a discounted bath for boarders that board 3 nights or longer. The discount is 30% off. If your pet does not qualify for the discounted bath, they can still get a bath at regular price.
